



Enid, Oklahoma's ordinance for loose dogs states that dogs, cats, ferrets, and potbellied pigs must be kept on the owner's property or confined with a leash or fence:

- **Confinement**

Dogs can be confined with a leash made of a strong material, like metal chain, or a substantial fence.

- **Registration**

Owners of dogs, cats, ferrets, and potbellied pigs over six months old must register them annually with the police department.

- **No sales in public**

Dogs and cats cannot be sold, traded, or given away in public parks or on public right of way.

- **Limit on pets**

No more than five dogs or cats over six months old are allowed per property, except for properties zoned for agriculture.
